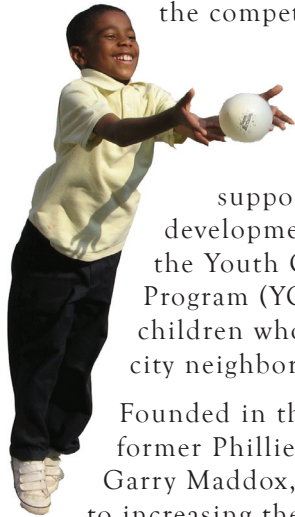


'Cuing for a cause...

Restaurant Division

Restaurants receive a tented booth with overhead signage and a serving counter. A limited number of charcoal grills are available for reservation on a first-come, first-served basis (one grill per restaurant). Thanks to a generous donation from Hatfield Quality Meats, restaurants also receive a donation of ribs for use in the contest or for public sampling (available for pick up at the event). Restaurants are permitted to provide samples of food to the public, but sales are not permitted. Please bring all ingredients (contest meat must be raw/uncooked upon arrival), coolers, ice, seasonings, preparation/cooking/holding items, side tables, chairs, and serving items. Please note, there is no electricity provided in the contest area. Contestants are responsible for adhering to all Department of Health regulations.

Pit Master Division

Any barbecue enthusiast can enter the contest through the Pit Master Division. Participating individuals or teams will be assigned a lot (10 feet wide/20 feet deep) in which to set up and cook. Thanks to a generous donation from Hatfield Quality Meats, contestants also receive a donation of ribs. Pit Master contestants are not permitted to offer samples of food to the public or to vend products. Please bring all ingredients (meat must be raw/uncooked upon arrival), ice, charcoal, seasonings, preparation/cooking/holding items, etc. Please note, there is no electricity provided in the contest area. Contestants are responsible for ensuring the cleanliness and safety of their operation and for adhering to all Health Department regulations.

Competition Format

Restaurant teams and pit master teams compete in separate divisions for bragging rights to the best barbecue. The day ends with Garry's Rib Challenge, a winner-take-all competition for a trip to the 2010 World Series, with no distinction between restaurants and pit masters. *One entry fee covers participation in any/all categories.* Contest rules will be sent upon receipt of completed registration.

Judging

A panel of judges including local celebrities, chefs, and food industry representatives determine whose 'cue takes the cake. Awards are presented for first through third place and honorable mention in the chicken, ribs, and chef's choice categories for both the restaurant and pit master divisions. Contestants are assigned control numbers under which they submit entries to ensure that judging remains blind. There will be one round of judging for all contest categories.
